Recommendations: The Committee recommends passage of the following resolution:

1.2.1 Short Title: Count Them All

Resolved, that in administering Section 6.5, a ballot should be counted if it has a vote for either the tentative winner or the run-off candidate or for both.

Discussion: Recently we have seen assertions that for the purposes of Section 6.5, a ballot should only be counted as preferring one candidate to another if the ballot lists both. Neither the legislative history nor the opinion of the authors of the current wording supports this, and we think it worth a moment of the Business Meeting's time to confirm this.
